## □ How to participate

#### • Participation Eligibility

A foreigner or overseas Korean (individual or group) for whom the Korean language is either a foreign (KFL) or second language (KSL)

\* Koreans may provide some assistance or partially participate in the process of video production, but foreigners should perform the major roles in the process.

#### • Video Format

- -Video must be your own original work, created in Korean, and
  - 5 to 8 minutes in length (no restriction on genre)
  - \*Production types include documentaries, interviews, news, and parodies. However, if you borrow scenes or music from existing works, the source should be credited.
- -In the video, Korean should be used as the main language of any conversation, and Korean subtitles should be provided for scenes containing dialog in English or other languages. If actors or actresses are not fluent in Korean, providing Korean subtitles is also recommended even when Korean is spoken.

#### • Theme (choose one of the themes below):
